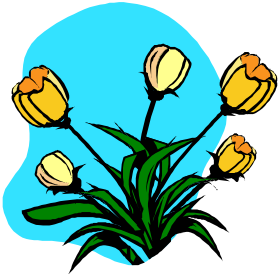

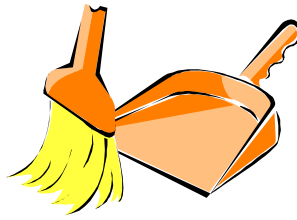




It's getting to be that time of year again...
